



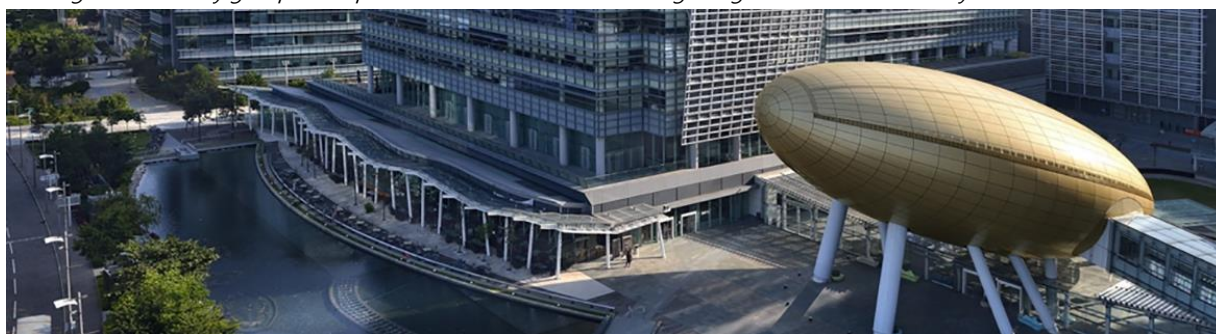

Participants in other groups can visit the official website: <a href="http://www.kiesicup.com">www.kiesicup.com</a> on 2 April 2024 (Tuesday) to check the grouping, latest information, and competition instructions.</li> <li>3. The venue opens for check-in 30 minutes before the start of competition. Participants who arrive more than 10 minutes late after the start of a game will be considered forfeiting.</li> <li>4. The organizers reserve the right to merge groups, split groups, and increase the number of rounds based on the number of participants.</li> <li>5. For some groups or tables, a chess clock may be used, and arbiters have the right to use it based on the actual competition situation.</li> <li>6. Arbiters have the right to stop abnormal moves that unreasonably consume the opponent's time. The Competition Committee has the final decision-making authority, and participants may not object.</li> <li>7. Participants are prohibited from using electronic devices during the game. Anyone found violating this rule may have their competition qualifications revoked.</li> <li>8. Cheating, including "collusion" or "use of AI," is strictly prohibited. If discovered, the participant will be disqualified from the competition. •</li> <li>9. Participants are expected to take good care of public property. **Venue Introduction:**

To provide participants with a higher quality and more comfortable competition venue, the "Kiesi Cup" Inter School Chess Tournament will be relocated to the Hong Kong Science Park and the Hong Kong Youth Chess Academy<sup>^</sup>. This move also sets a new record for hosting a local inter-school chess event in the largest single indoor space.

Hong Kong Science Park, located in Sha Tin, is well-known for its comfortable waterfront promenade and the distinctive "Golden Egg"(Charles K. Kao Auditorium) structure. The park is conveniently located, with a travel time of only 10 minutes from either Sha Tin MTR station or University MTR station by public transportation. The park also offers over 1,500 parking spaces for the convenience of drivers. In addition, with over 30 different types of restaurants, participants and accompanying parents can enjoy a convenient dining experience. The comprehensive facilities provided will undoubtedly ensure that participants have a memorable and enjoyable chess competition experience.

## "Best Girl Chess Player" (Primary School Groups)

**Purpose :** The "Best Female Chess Player" award is established to encourage more girl players to participate in the competition and demonstrate their skills.

**System :** The award will be given to the best-performing girl player in seven groups

**Seven groups:** Weiqi(Junior, Middle & Senior), XiangQi and Chess(Junior and Senior).

The calculation method for the award is based on comparing the "Total Score" and the "Opponent Score."

## "Special Commendation Award" (Preschool Group)

**Purpose :** The "Special Commendation Award" is established to recognize participants who have displayed good attitude during the competition.

**System :** The referee and coaching team will select one award recipient in each group based on the students' performance and attitude.

## Procedure for Applying for Certificates

To support environmental protection, participants can visit the competition website [www.kiesicup.com](http://www.kiesicup.com) between 5 April 2024 and 19 April 2024, to fill in the required information for applying for participation certificates or ranking certificates. Late applications will not be accepted.



Applicants can collect the certificates from the selected branch of the Hong Kong China Chess School on or after 20 May 2024.
